

Warranty Conditions

- 1** The warranty has a validity of 60 months (5 years) from the date of the invoice.
 - 2** Unless otherwise stated by written document, the warranty on the units sold by Space Cannon Australia is carried out in Space Cannon Australia's factory.
 - 3** The warranty is valid only for the parts damaged due to proven faults in the material, manufacturing or assembly. The warranty does not include the cost of transport, nor the assembling nor disassembling costs of the fixtures.
 - 4** The warranty is not valid:
 - a)** for damages on the units due to negligence of the Buyer;
 - b)** for damages caused by current overload or incorrect connections;
 - c)** for unauthorised work
 - d)** tampering carried out or ordered to be carried out by the Buyer;
 - e)** following fortuitous events and/or Force Majeure.
 - 5** Nothing will be due to the Buyer for the period during which the equipment remains unused, and the Buyer cannot claim any reimbursements or compensation for expenses or losses resulting from the above-mentioned repairs or replacements.
 - 6** All other spare parts that Space Cannon Australia will consider under warranty will be shipped at no-cost value; the transport is always at the Buyer's expense. All faulty parts must be shipped back to Space Cannon Australia for checking and accompanied by a document from the Buyer. All shipment charges will be at the Buyer's expense.
 - 7** The warranty does not include:
 - a)** safety glasses and lenses;
 - b)** dichroic filters;
 - c)** reflectors;
- For the above-mentioned parts the general warranty conditions of the manufacturers are to be considered as valid. The warranty does not cover damages occurred during transportation even if shipment costs are at Space Cannon Australia's expense.
- 8** Space Cannon Australia declines all penal or civil liability for any damages caused to persons, objects and/or animals during the transport and the operation of the equipment.
 - 9** Any use of the equipment other than those mentioned in the instruction manual must be authorised in writing by Space Cannon Australia.
 - 10** Any modification by Distributors and/or End Users must always be authorised in writing by Space Cannon Australia. Any unauthorised intervention will make the warranty null and void.
 - 11** When the Buyer requires a technical intervention on site, all expenses (cost of intervention, spare parts not under warranty, flights etc) will be invoiced to the Buyer and paid by the Buyer prior to the intervention. The Buyer will take care of board and lodging of the technicians directly on site.
 - 12** If the Buyer does not ask for technical intervention on site and if repairing and/or replacing under warranty can be done only at Space Cannon Australia's facility, the Client will be requested to ship the fixtures where they will be checked and repaired.
 - 13** The Buyer must get in touch with the Technical Dept. of Space Cannon Australia to plan the repairs at Space Cannon Australia's facility or at any other authorised site.
 - 14** Any dispute arising out of or in connection with these conditions and/or any other legal relationship between the Seller and the Buyer shall be submitted to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts in Victoria.
